

**MINUTES

PRESENT: Councilmembers Clarkson, Copeland, King, and Gibert.
Councilmember Biles was absent.

Councilmember King made a motion to adjourn into Executive Session to discuss pending ligations at 5:30 p.m. seconded by Councilmember Gibert and carried unanimously.

There being no action taken, a motion to adjourn Executive Session at 6:55 p.m. was made by Councilmember Gibert, seconded by Councilmember Clarkson and carried unanimously.

Mayor Kennedy called the Work Session to order at 7:00 p.m.

City Manager's Report and Staff Recommendations:

Request for approval of revised plan for Senior Connection Housing.

Melody Olson, Mercy Housing, addressed the Mayor and Council with reference to changing the location of the senior housing project behind the Senior Connection building.

Appoint committee to review responses to RFQ for planning services?

The proposals are due by noon on Friday, February 18, 2005. The committee will be appointed at the Regular Council Meeting.

Request for support from Chamblee High School.

The High School's new Constitutional scholars' class, called *We the People*, won the State of Georgia competition. In order to participate in the competition the class must raise \$18,000 by March 1st and is requesting financial assistance.

The PTSA of the High School is requesting financial assistance to complete the renovation of the main courtyard. A list of items needed was submitted to the Council.

Request for direction All American City application.

Because of the timeline the Council decided not to submit an application for 2005. This item will be removed from the agenda.

CADA revisions to festival contract.

Several members of the Chamblee Antique Dealers Association were present. The proposed contracts were reviewed and changes made before final approval at the Regular Council Meeting.

Requests to approve budget amendments:

- **Public Works employment claim.**

A budget amendment in the amount of \$2,000 will need to be made to pay the reimbursable unemployment for Jerry Mason.

- **Design for signal at intersection of Peachtree Road and Chamblee Tucker Road.**

PBS&J is proposing the Chamblee Tucker Road streetscape be amended to include a signal design for its intersection with Peachtree Road. A design plan can be added into the current set of plans with a cost of approximately \$2,000 for the design.

Usage of the Keswick Park Community Center for Chamblee Arts Alliance monthly meetings.

Councilmember Clarkson presented this item to the Mayor and Council. The Chamblee Arts Alliance is requesting the use of the Keswick Park Community Center for their monthly meeting. The CAA is also requesting the deposit and rental fee be waived.

Clairmont Road Speed Limit.

Councilmember Gibert presented this item to the Mayor and Council. A copy of Councilmember Gibert's concerns is on file with the City Clerk. After some discussion, Chief Johnson will address issues discussed with reference to the speed limit and advise.
