

**MINUTES

PRESENT: Councilmember Wedge, Copeland, King, Gibert, and Taylor

Mayor Clarkson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Discuss Annexation.

Senator Dan Weber was present to discuss annexation (he is presenting legislation to form the City of Dunwoody). After some discussion, the elected officials outlined the proposed boundaries to annex in the City. Councilmember Wedge made a motion to move forward with the annexation and to fund a not to exceed amount of \$5000 for a survey with reference to the area to be considered for annexation (copy of the legal description of the proposed property to be annexed is included in the Minutes). The motion was seconded by Councilmember Copeland and carried with Councilmember Wedge, Copeland, Gibert, and Taylor voting in favor and Councilmember King opposed.

Discuss New Zoning Ordinance changes.

Dan Cohen, City Planner (Pond & Company) and Aaron Fortner, were present to discuss changes to the ordinance and the reason to postpone the second reading (a copy of the outline as presented is included in the Minutes). The changes made will require a new first reading and Public Hearing date. The first reading will be at the March 21, 2006, Regular Council Meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:55 p.m.
