PUBLIC HEARING – 2010 MILLAGE RATE (2 of 3)
Tuesday, July 5, 2011 – 11:30 a.m.

The hearing was called to order at 11:30 a.m. by Mayor Clarkson.

Council Members present were: Mr. Tom Hogan, Ms. Leslie Robson, and Mr. Dan Zanger.

Staff Members present were: Dr. Niles Ford, City Manager; Mr. Marc Johnson, Police Chief; Mr. Travis Sims, Finance Director; and Ms. Nancy Williams, City Clerk.

Mr. Clarkson read the rules of order. Copies of the 5-year history with the notice of tax increase, which have been published in the newspaper, were available at the hearing.

Mayor Clarkson called the hearing to order and opened the floor for public comments.

Mr. Doyle Shugart addressed Council and asked how much of a tax increase was being considered. Mayor Clarkson said that the purpose of the public hearings was to hear citizen input concerning the millage rate and that the City Council would take action to set the millage rate at another time. Mayor Clarkson said no rate increase had been advertised so the only action the City Council could take would be to maintain the current millage rate or to lower it.

Hearing no further comments, the hearing was adjourned by unanimous consent at 11:45 a.m.
