## Mark your calendar, ***BRING*** your friends and family -- *Chamblee is turning 100 years old!*

On August 16, 2008, Chamblee will host a big birthday bash and the entire city is invited. The celebration kicks off at 2:00pm at the Chamblee Civic Center. The history of Chamblee's first 100 years will be on display inside the Civic Center, with pictorial displays and even a documentary film! The film has been in production for many months, with interviews of Chamblee's oldest citizens and well-known community members. You won't want to miss this professional visual rendition of Chamblee's collective memories. If you arrive early, you'll be treated to cake and ice cream, compliments of the City! Also, train enthusiasts will be excited to see displays of an O-Gauge and N-Scale railroad trains set up by North Atlanta O-Gauge Railroad Club & Metro Atlanta N-Scalers, respectively.

Surrounding the outside perimeter of the Civic Center is more family fun. There will be a classic car show highlighting antique cars, trucks & motorcycles. The car show will also include a performance by the local Sexton Woods Band, "Legs". Arts & Craft vendors will be selling their handmade wares, ranging from jewelry and woodworking to painting and photography. Food will be for sale by local restaurants and festival food vendors. Children can enjoy clowns, face painters, interactive games like bouncy houses, train rides and other exciting games! There will even be storytelling performed by an old-time Chamblee local, Mrs. Rosemary Glen.

Music-lovers will be thrilled to hear live performances all day long. Kicking off performances at the "Old-Time Music Stage" will be "Cross-Town Traffic", followed by Atlanta's renowned bluegrass stars, "The Dappled Grays". Also performing that afternoon is "Legs".

At 6:00 pm, the music will be continued around the corner with the dedication of the new Chamblee Centennial Park, next door to City Hall. The dedication ceremony will begin at 6:00pm, recognizing Chamblee's former elected officials and setting the stage for Chamblee's next 100 years.

Following the dedication ceremony, an outdoor concert lasting until 10:00 pm will break in the new park. The crowd-pleasers from the Taste of Chamblee, "MisConduct", will once again rock the City as they ring in Chamblee's future. Attendees will be able to enjoy an outdoor beer garden, food sales and dancing.
