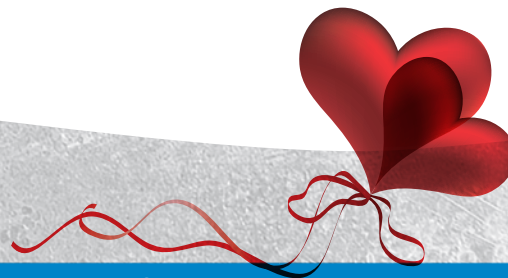

Is your teenager's life worth two hours of your time? Register today for Georgia Teens Ride with P.R.I.D.E. (Parents Reducing Injuries and Driver Error).

The free two-hour course is designed to help parents and their new teen drivers, ages 14 to 16, learn during 40 hours of supervised practice driving time. The program goes beyond a technical hands-on driver training course to address driver attitude, knowledge and behavior. Completion of the course doesn't count toward the required 40 hours of supervised driving practice that a teen must complete before getting a driver's license.

### A few reminders:

Use the crosswalk when one is available. Crosswalks provide physical and legal protection. Crossing the street outside a crosswalk and near it is dangerous.

Pedestrian violations include:

- Not yielding to vehicles while crossing outside a crosswalk
- Crossing in a crosswalk during a solid Don't Walk signal and walking in the roadway while intoxicated by alcohol or drugs
