## Chamblee Seniors Breakfast Club

The October meeting of the Chamblee Seniors Breakfast Club is set for Oct. 6, 2011 at 10:30 a.m. at the Civic Center. The speaker will be Rosemary Neidel-Greenlee, an author and former nurse with the U.S. Navy Nurse Corps, who will speak on the role of women in the military service.

With co-author Dr. Evelyn M. Monahan, Neidel-Greenlee has written four books, including *Albanian Escape: the True Story of U.S. Army Nurses Behind Enemy Lines* and *All this Hell: U.S. Nurses Imprisoned by the Japanese*. Another of their titles, *And If I Perish: Frontline U.S. Army Nurses in World War II*, won the Georgia Writers' Association Award in both the history and nonfiction categories in 2004. Their most recent book is *A Few Good Women: America's Military Women from WW I to the Wars in Iraq and Afghanistan*.

A mother of two sons, Neidel-Greenlee retired from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs in 2002 and now lives in Brookhaven.

She received her undergraduate degree in nursing from University at Buffalo School of Nursing and her graduate degree from Emory University in Atlanta.

## Code Enforcement

**Sec. 1303. Property address signs.** Property addresses (including multi-family building or unit numbers) are not signs when displayed on a building or mailbox, provided that such property address consists of lettering at least six inches but no larger than eight inches in height on a nonresidential use, or three inches in height on a residential building or mailbox.
