## CHAMBLEE RECEIVES DOUBLE RECOGNITION FOR COMMUNICATIONS EXCELLENCE

November 8, 2019—The City of Chamblee was recently awarded the Bronze Flame and the Gold MARCOM awards for communications excellence. The flame award was given to the city at the 2019 International Association of Business Communicators (IABC) Atlanta Golden Flame celebration. The flame was awarded in the Communication Skills/Publications category for the "Come and See Chamblee" brochure. The MARCOM was in the Print Media, Marketing/Promotional Materials and Guides category, also for the "Come & See Chamblee" brochure.

The "Come & See Chamblee" guide is a fast and convenient way to tell businesses' stories and engage audiences while also promoting the city through Georgia's Convention and Visitors' Bureaus. Atlanta is the #1 food city in the nation as far as money spent on dining out. We wanted to capitalize on the culinary interest in adjacent Chamblee. The guide also includes boutiques and galleries in the city, all which are color-coded for ease of use.

The Golden Flame awards recognize exceptional examples of advertising, marketing and communication programs as judged by an international panel of peer-professionals. Overall, 18 companies earned 45 awards: 26 gold, 5 silver and 14 bronze all for business communication excellence.

The MARCOMs are the industry's preeminent third-party evaluator of creative work. The organization has judged more than 20,000 entries since 1994. Each year about 6,000 print and digital entries are submitted from dozens of countries.
