



## Chamblee City Council Meeting Review 8/17/2021

The Chamblee City Council approved a partnership with the Chamblee Doraville Community Improvement District (CID) to design and construct sidewalks on Peachtree Boulevard. This initiative will bring visible, practical improvements to the pedestrian experience along this well-traveled community corridor.

The Council also approved partnering with the City of Doraville and the Chamblee Doraville CID to advance the Peachtree Boulevard North Gateway Project. This initiative is part of a larger Peachtree Boulevard access project in the adopted Chamblee Mobility Plan. The project seeks to pursue a safer and more efficient design to improve safety, increase the efficiency of traffic operations and minimize traffic delay at the intersection of Peachtree Boulevard, Peachtree Road, North Shallowford Road, and Parsons Drive.

Council approved adjusted pay increases for several city positions in public works and public safety. In a concentrated effort to stay competitive with salaries and stay in line with the accelerated job growth due to COVID-19, city leadership proposed this measure to keep up with the high demand from these positions.

Several variances were deferred to the next council meeting including:

- Renovation and beautification efforts at the Dunwoody Exchange Apartments
- Renovation of a vacant restaurant located at 5480 Peachtree Road.
- New field lighting at St. Pius X Catholics School
