SUMMARY

• Approval to authorize a contract with Balance Design Atlanta in the amount of \$50,000 to conduct interior design work at City Hall. Balance Design Atlanta will focus on the lobby, community room, outdoor spaces and meeting rooms to bring a more welcoming, community centered atmosphere to City Hall. An additional \$500,000 will be set aside for implementation.

• Approval to authorize a contract with Strategic Government Resources (SGR) for Police Chief recruitment services in the amount of \$24,900. SGR will conduct a national search on behalf of the city.

• Annual appointments were made to the Urban Redevelopment Agency (URA). Mayor Brian Mock was appointed to serve as Chair and Mayor Pro Tem Leslie Robson was appointed to serve as Vice Chair of the URA.

• Approval to move forward and complete renovations at Dresden Park. Council voted to increase the square footage of the proposed new building at the park to 6,566 total square feet. The \$2 million building will be completed by 2025.

• Approval to authorize the use of stormwater funds in the amount of \$192, 508.04 to construct two raingardens with fieldstone boulders and landscaping at Arrow Creek Park. Remaining funds from the 2019 URA Bond will also be used to construct slate and boardwalk trail with amenities.

SUMMARY

- Approval to authorize a contract with Queen Art & Design for the 2023 Chamblee Chalk Walk initiated by District Four Councilmember Elmer Veith. The Chamblee Public Arts Commission plans to host the Chamblee Chalk Walk at City Hall on September 23, 2023. The three-part chalk art experience will feature installations of professional chalk art, a community chalk art competition, and community chalk art activities. The event will also include food vendors, art vendors and music.
- Approval of the Chamblee Public Arts Commission to replace “Irving” the piano along the Rail Trail. “Irving” the piano is currently six-years-old and is due for retirement. The funds to replace the piano are not to exceed \$4,000.
